Carolyn was born January 23, 1945 in Travis, Texas and was the daughter of Richard and Lazara (Cisneros) Veracruz. Carolyn married Leo Warren Dubey on July 7, 1962 in St. Frances on the Brazos Catholic Church in Waco, Texas and they shared 52 years of blissful marriage. During Leo's military career they lived many places including Rockdale for the past 14 years, Waco, Austin, Round Rock, Brenham, Lubbock, Amarillo and Del Rio just naming some of the Texas cities. Carolyn owned and operated a beauty shop in Waco for five years and then taught cosmetology at Waco High and then at Johnston High School in Austin for 18 years at which time her health dictated early retirement in 1996. She then with her husband Leo became foster parents to "at risk children" who had been removed from their homes for the next 18 years. Together they loved and nurtured a total of 55 foster children.

Carolyn was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Rockdale and was continuously active in her church and was involved in many ministries. She

was dedicated to God, her family, and the Catholic Church.

Carolyn passed away on Friday, September 26, 2014 at Scott & White Hospital in Temple with her family at her side. She reached the age of 69 years, 8 months and 3 days. She was preceded in death by a son, Leo Michael Dubey. Father, Richard Veracruz.

Surviving are her husband of 52 years, Leo Dubey of Rockdale. Two sons, Larry Dubey of Rockdale and Bradley Dubey of Rockdale. Her 99 year old mother, Lazara Veracruz of Waco.
