



Cecil "Chee" Froebe Reynolds II

July 30, 1945 - September 15, 2021

Graveside services for Cecil "Chee" Reynolds II, 76 of Lexington, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, September 17, 2021 at the Lexington Cemetery with Rev. Raegan Seaton officiating.

Cecil Froebe Reynolds II was born on July 30, 1945 in Houston, Texas to Cecil Froebe Reynolds Sr. and Edna (Cherry) Reynolds. He served in the US Army from June 1966 to May 1968 in the armor intelligence division. Cecil was confirmed at the Milby United Methodist Church in Houston. He worked many years at the George Bush Intercontinental Airport in Houston as a shuttle driver for the park and ride lots. Cecil enjoyed watching westerns, gardening, and doing charcoal artwork. Being active in his community, he was a member of American Legion Post 6 in Lexington and the Lexington Lions Club and at the Lexington Senior Citizen Center and volunteered for the Lexington United Methodist Free Will Lunch program. He was always willing to lend a hand to anyone in need. Cecil will be remembered as being very gracious.

Cecil passed away the morning of Wednesday, September 15, 2021 at his home in Lexington.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Cecil and Edna Reynolds; one daughter, Allison Hardaway, and one brother, Clayton Reynolds.
