



Cesario "Charlie" Garza

March 2, 1930 - January 25, 2019

Cesario (Charlie) Garza, 88, of Caldwell (Formerly of Dimmitt, TX) passed away peacefully on January 25, 2019. Visitation will be held Monday, January 28, from 5 to 8 pm at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Caldwell with a Rosary recited at 7 pm. Mass of a Christian burial will be held at 10 am on Tuesday, January 29, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Dime Box. Father Joy Adimakkeel will preside over services. Burial will follow services at St. Joseph's Catholic Cemetery in Dime Box.

He was born March 2, 1930, in George West, TX, to Eluteria Garza. He married Felicita Savala on November 21, 1949. Together, they had 11 children.

Cesario was orphaned by the age of 9. As a youth, he worked custodial jobs in Steele's Store (Mudville), TX. As a young man, he played minor league baseball for the Lone Star League. After he married, he and Felicita moved to the Texas Panhandle, where he worked as a farm hand and repaired farm equipment. Primarily as a self-taught man, he discovered he had an aptitude for growing productive crops and fixing machinery, and was often called upon in the community when farm equipment repair was needed. He was well respected as a man of integrity, with a strong work ethic in all communities in which he lived throughout his life. Cesario valued his family and friends. He greatly enjoyed cookouts and visits with loved ones. He enjoyed fishing, gardening, and was always ready for a competitive game of dominoes. Cesario was strong in his Catholic faith, attending St. Joseph's Catholic

Church in Dime Box, TX.

Mr. Garza was preceded in death by Felicita, his loving wife of 66 years. His son, Andres Garza, and daughters Mary Correa and Alice Casas, also preceded him in death.

He is survived by his sons, Charlie Garza and Nicolas Garza of Caldwell, TX; Mario (Adela) Garza of Lubbock, TX, and Fermin (Kim) Garza of Bushland, TX. He also is survived by his daughters, Dora Garza of College Station, TX; Abelia Garza of Caldwell, TX; Teresa (John) Garth of Hereford, TX; and Hope Sifuentes of Austin, TX. Additionally, he is survived by 35 grandchildren, 53 great-grandchildren, and 9 great-great grandchildren.
