Charles C. Holder, age 92 of Rockdale, passed away Friday, May 6, 2022 in the Baylor Scott & White Hospital in Temple.

Mr. Holder was born March 24, 1930 in Palmer, Texas David and Massey (Moon) Holder. He was raised in Itasca, Texas and graduated High School from there. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict from March 1951 and honorably discharged as a Staff Sargent in December 1952. He moved to Rockdale in 1954 and on August 19, 1954, he and Emelia Whitley were married in Rockdale. He is a member of First Baptist Church. Charles worked as a welder with Alcoa and retired in 1993.

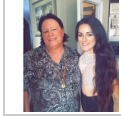
