Charles Joseph Matula, Jr., 81 of Rockdale, formerly of Cameron, passed away on Saturday, June 4, 2022 at his home in Rockdale. A Celebration of Life will be held at 10 a.m. on Saturday, June 18, 2022 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale.

Charles Joseph Matula, Jr., known by many as Mat or Charlie, was born on March 15, 1941 to Charles Joseph Matula, Sr. and Lois Mary (Provasek) Matula in Cameron. He graduated from Yoe High School in Cameron. He proudly served in the United States Navy, while there he started his electrical career. 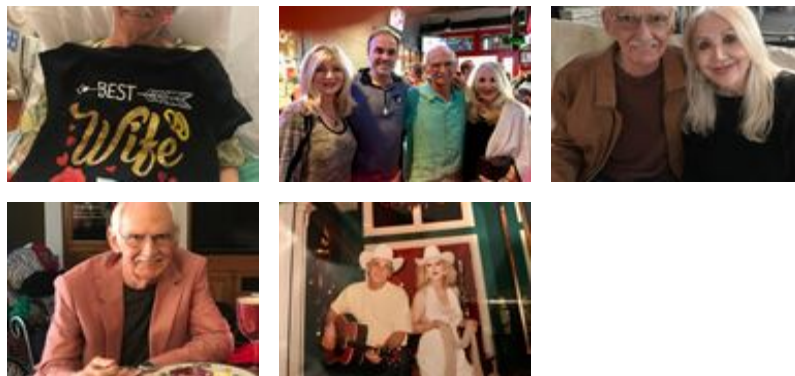
