Funeral services for Charles "Chuck" Olbrich will be 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 11, 2019 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale with Pastor Scott Schaller of Trinity Lutheran Church in Taylor officiating. Burial will follow in the Thorndale City Cemetery in Thorndale.

Our Batman, husband, dad and son may be gone from this earth, but he is forever

with us.

He passed away Friday night, September 6, 2019 in the Baylor Scott & White Hospital in Taylor, at the age of 62. He was preceded in death by his father, Carl Olbrich and his sister, Marlene Drummond.

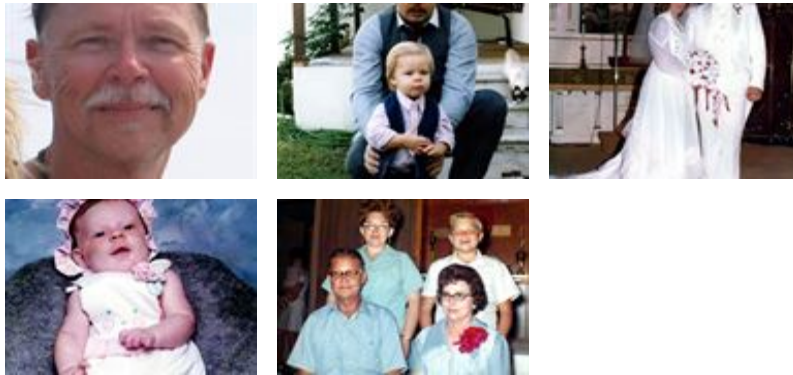
