Charles Edward Ward, born July 26, 1924 in Gouldbusk, Texas to Henry Edward and Elsie Josephine (Hickey) Ward. He served in the U.S. Army receiving the Purple Heart and Victory Medal during World War II. He lived in Pflugerville the past 16 years and had lived in Austin, Lake Travis and Rockdale. Charles worked for Missouri-Pacific Railroad 1951 to 1957 then the Austin Police Department as their fingerprint expert. He retired in December 1981. On September 10, 1950, he and Nanette Fieseler were married in Rockdale. Charles passed away Monday, May 3rd, in the North Austin Medical Center reaching the age of 85.
