



## Charles Wayne Winkler

April 15, 1960 - May 6, 2025

Funeral services for Charles Winkler, 65 of Fedor, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, May 12, 2025 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor, Texas with Rev. Jonathan Meyer officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Sunday, May 11, 2025 from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Monday, May 12, 2025 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Sunday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Charles Wayne Winkler was born on April 15, 1960 in Giddings, Texas, the oldest child of Herbert Otto Winkler and Alleen Annie (Boriack) Winkler. He was baptized on April 24, 1960 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor by Rev. August Horn and confirmed on April 7, 1974 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln by Rev. Robert Koenig. His confirmation verse was 1 John 1:9, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness". Charles attended grade school at St. John Lutheran School in Lincoln and graduated in the top three from Lexington High School in 1978. While in school, he was involved in 4-H where he was on the rifle team and achieved the Gold Star Boy Award. He was also active in FFA and raised show hogs. Charles spent many hours frog gigging, rabbit hunting, and fishing. He played community softball and was on Fedor's team "The Dukes". Growing up, he enjoyed spending Friday nights at Fedor Store and all the shenanigans that came with along with that and Saturday nights at

the dances in Dime Box.

On February 20, 1988, Charles was united in marriage to Debra Ewing at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Charles Ager. He retired from the United States Postal Service after 28 years as a rural mail carrier. Charles was a faithful member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor where he was a Sunday school teacher and had served in several officer positions and on several special committees for the church. He was heavily involved with the Lee County Junior Livestock Show where he had served as a director of the board and was president of the Fedor Volunteer Fire Department for over 30 years. He enjoyed the country life along with farming, tractors, and tinkering on projects. He seemed to always be able to find a great deal while shopping the Couchbidders online auctions. He will be remembered as a loving and very loved husband, father, brother and uncle who enjoyed his time joking and helping and visiting with family and friends.

Charles passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, May 6, 2025 at his home in Fedor.

He was preceded in death by his father, Herbert Winkler.
