Charlie Janak, 87, of Rockdale, Texas, passed away Saturday, July 21, 2018. Mass is scheduled for 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, July 25, 2018 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Rockdale, Texas with Father Pedro Castillo and Father Gary Janak officiating. Burial will be at Our Lady of the Holy Rosary Cemetery in Frenstat, Texas at 2:30 pm. Visitation will be held at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home on Tuesday, July 24, 2018 from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm with the Rosary recited at 7:00 pm.

Charlie was born November 4, 1930 to Rudolph Janak and Julia (Fikac) Janak in Shiner, Texas. He worked at Tex Tanner in Yoakum and the Cotton Mill, then at Chicken Stahlbris in Gonzales. Charlie married Evelyn D. Rehak on January 30, 1951. He was drafted to the army for two years, and received his basic training at Camp Roberts in California. He went overseas to Korea, and upon his return, he received a job with Alcoa in November 1954 in Rockdale, Texas. He worked there for 38 years and retired in July 1992.

Charlie enjoyed working on his farm and loved learning about the agriculture industry. He passed on his knowledge and love of farming to his grandson, Wesley Janak, who continues the family cattle business. Charlie was an honorary member of the Knights of Columbus, VFW, and the American Legion. He was a dedicated parishioner of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Rockdale.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his sons, Mark & Michael Janak; five brothers, Antone, Alex, Celestine, Leon, and Joe; and two sisters, Frances Anderle and Staycie Wagner.

He is survived by his wife, Evelyn; his brother, Victor and wife Doris; his grandson, Wesley Janak and wife Jessica; his granddaughter, Chrystie Butler and husband, Clint; great grandkids, Caylee and Case Butler, Luke Janak, Brayden and Gracey Burns.
