Charlie Frank Morgan, age 78 of Rockdale, passed away Monday, June 20, 2022 at his home near Rockdale.

He was born January 1, 1944 in Milano to Charlie Ray and Blanche Gertrude (Newman) Morgan. Charlie Frank was a graduate of Milano High School, Class of 1962. While in school, he was an all-around athlete. After graduation, he served in the U.S. Navy on the USS North Hampton from 1962 until 1966.
