Charlotte Ann (Tucker) Roepke, 72, of Taylor, formerly of Rockdale, passed away peacefully on October 16, 2023 following a brief illness. A Celebration of Life service will be held Tuesday October 24th at 2pm at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home, Rockdale, with Pastors Michael Roepke and Ronnie Dyer, officiating. Burial will follow at Salty Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 6-8pm, Monday October 23rd, also at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home, Rockdale.

Charlotte was born April 19, 1951, in Cameron, Texas, to Charles Allen “Buddy” & Dorothy Laverne (Stephens) Tucker. Her Faith was a vital part of her life and over the years, she was a member at First Baptist Church, Rockdale; Forest Grove Christian Church, Rockdale; New Hope Christian Church, Hutto; and visited many other churches around Central Texas to support her sons' respective ministries.

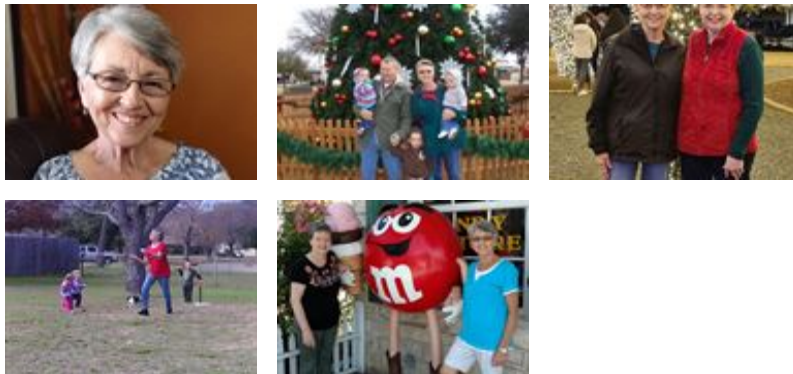
