April 8, 1925 - August 12, 2024

Christene (Chris) Hart Wall went home to be with our Lord, Jesus Christ, on August 12, 2024 at 99 years old. Chris was born on April 8, 1925, to Jake C. Hart and Eudora Massy in Calvert, Texas located in Roberston County. Chris graduated from Calvert High School in 1943 and moved to San Antonio, Texas to live with her sister Helen Hart. In San Antonio she met the love of her life and her future husband of 74 years, George Wall. In 1953 Chris and George moved to Rockdale, Texas where George worked for Alcoa Aluminum Company of America and where they raised their 3 children and lived for over 65 years.

Growing up in Calvert, Texas in the 1920's was not easy when you are number 5 of 7 siblings. Chris learned many of her life lessons and talents from her loving mother, Eudora Hart, who at the age of 40 became a widow raising 7 kids during the Great Depression in the 1930's. Through abundant family love, teamwork and tenacity Chris and her siblings thrived. After the end of World War II, Chris and her sister Helen went to visit their brother Don who was injured during the war and was a patient at the Brooke Army Medical Center hospital in San Antonio. During this visit Chris met her brother's roommate, George Wall, who would soon become her husband for over 74 years. Chris and George married in 1950.

Chris Wall was a shining example of God's love for all by freely giving her

love, time and talents to others. As an ambassador of God's love for others, Chris was loved by all who knew her because she took time daily to love and serve others. She prepared countless meals for the sick, shut-ins, friends, family and strangers over 60 years. Her famous and delicious Italian Cream Cakes were well known and always in demand. Chris was a loving wife and mother with a gift for nurturing and encouraging others. She had a quick wit and easy laugh and enjoyed entertaining family and friends. Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter were especially joyful occasions for Chris and family. She was a devoted member of the Rockdale United Methodist Church for over 65 years faithfully supporting pastors and members. Chris believed in the power of prayer and was our family "prayer warrior".

As a wife, mom, grandmother and great grandmother, she was a model of devotion and a constant example of love for others by her actions. She provided wise encouragement to her children to work hard to accomplish their goals while staying grounded to Christian values. She had high standards for herself and her family as she exemplified daily. Beauty was important to Chris. She devoted many hours of love and sweat to her home and yard that was filled with beautiful roses, azaleas, camellias, lilies. She made sure her husband George kept the grass just right – even when he complained about the water bill. She always gave proper attention to her appearance. Her stunning styled white hair complimented with stylish clothes and attractive jewelry was her trademark. Chris was the family smart shopper. Her children, grands and friends always enjoyed a shopping day at the mall with Chris.

Chris is survived by her husband, George Wall Sr, and three Children, son George Wall Jr and Martha of Devine, TX.; son Keith Wall and Missy of Huntsville, TX. and daughter Diane Galownia and Paul of Conroe, TX.
