Funeral services for Christopher "Loebau" Baker, 47 of Giddings, will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, February 1, 2021 at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Rev. Dustin Beck officiating. A visitation will be held on Sunday, January 31, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Monday, February 1, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. at the funeral home. The family will be present for visitation Sunday evening from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Christopher Leon Baker was born on July 15, 1973 in Houston, Texas, the son of Wayne Murrell Baker Jr. and Beverly Jean Odom. He attended Dime Box High School. On October 16, 2020, he and Barbara Wishert were married in Las Vegas, Nevada. Loebau had worked for Altman Plants as well as P & L Testing and was currently employed with Dig Tech. He had also been a member of both the Lincoln and Giddings Volunteer Fire Departments. A former member of Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau, he had served as Sunday school superintendent and helped with the annual picnic. Loebau loved music. He was the former sound man for the County Road 114 Band and was a huge supporter of local bands and musicians. He loved woodworking and restoring and refurbishing things and was looking forward to beginning the renovations on he and Barbara's new home they recently purchased. Loebau was always finding a reason to be outside and staying busy whether it was barbecuing, fishing, taking the boat out to the lake, or playing with his dogs, Dixie and Bandit. Loebau enjoyed meeting new people

and once he met you, you were never a stranger again. He always looked forward to the time he was able to spend with his grandkids.

Loebau passed away, with his family by his side, the afternoon of Tuesday, January 26, 2021 in a Bryan hospital.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

Loebau is survived by his wife, Barbara Baker of Giddings; his two daughters, Gabrielle Teinert & her husband, Clinton of Giddings and Caitlyn Zoch & her husband, David of Giddings; two step children, Faith Wishert & her fiancé, Manuel Martinez of Cuero, and Colton Wishert & his wife, Ashley of Leesville; four grandchildren, Conner Zoch and Lennox Zoch both of Giddings, Logan Teinert of Giddings, Brooklyn Wishert of Leesville and two more grandchildren expected to arrive in April and May; one sister, Pauline Cotten & her husband, Chris of Cullen, AL, and two brothers, Travis Curtiss & his wife Megan of Stockton, CA and Wesley Odom & his wife, Tania Guzman-Odom of Arlington. 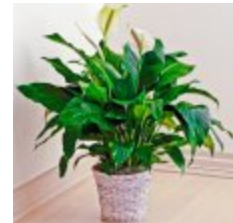

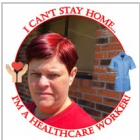
