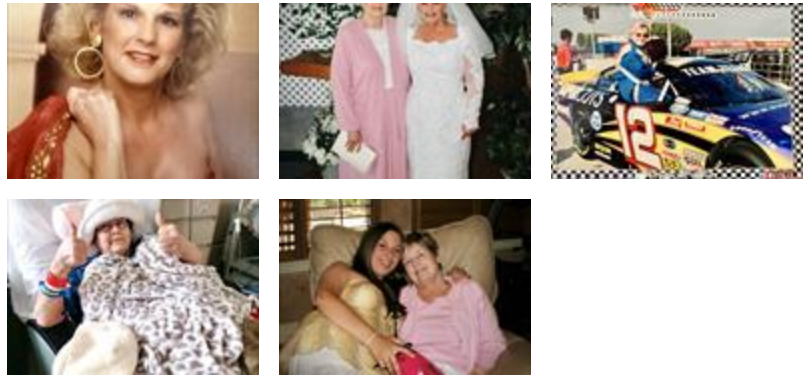

*You are greatly missed and loved beyond measure. I'm still processing that you're no longer physically here. I feel you were called home way too early for us, but that's just me being selfish.*



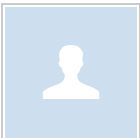
