



## Clara Gertrude Reveley-Pecht

August 22, 1915 - September 4, 2015

Funeral services for Clara Reveley-Pecht, 100 of Houston, are scheduled for 12:30 p.m. on Thursday, September 10, 2015 at the Evangelical Lutheran Church of the Redeemer in Houston with Rev. Grant W. 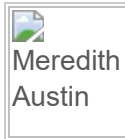

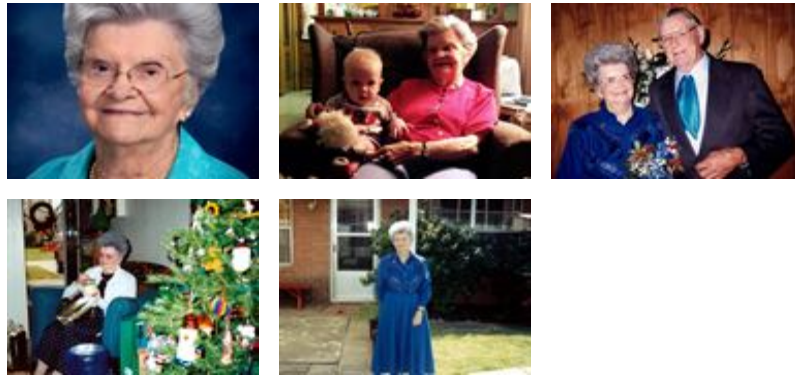
