He was a Lutheran Church Missouri Synod teacher having served at Mt. Calvary Lutheran School in Denver, Colorado, Trinity Lutheran School in San Angelo, Trinity Lutheran School in Tyler and retired as principal from Grace Lutheran School in Brenham. Clarence also taught in the Brenham ISD and had been employed with Brenham Memorial Funeral Home and was

currently employed with Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. He enjoyed spending time with his family and going fishing, hunting, gardening and playing dominoes and bridge. He enjoyed his time spent with the Boy Scouts in a leadership role with troops in Tyler and in Brenham. He had fond memories of his time hiking and training at Philmont. Clarence loved all of the various churches he had served and held many offices and positions in them throughout the years. He was preceded in death by his parents, Oscar & Elsie Weiser and a son, Samuel Weiser.
