



Clyde E. Luetge

Funeral services for Clyde E. Luetge, 80 of Thorndale, formerly of Rockdale are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. Sunday, March 6, 2016 in Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale with burial to follow in the Oak Lawn Cemetery in Rockdale. Clyde was born October 12, 1935 in the New Salem Community near Rockdale to Louie and Lillian (Edwards) Luetge, Sr. He was a 1954 graduate of Rockdale High School. While attending school, he was a standout athlete. In 2007, he was inducted into the very first class of the Rockdale Sports Hall of Honor, honoring him for his remarkable achievements in three sports at RHS.

On February 25, 1956, he and Shirley Cardwell were married in the First Christian Church in Rockdale. To this union three children were born, Debra, Robert and James. He worked at McVoy Grocery in Rockdale prior to joining Louie Luetge and Sons Processing. He also was a rancher. He was a member of Rockdale Christian Church and enjoyed sports, gardening, fishing, hunting, playing dominoes and spending time with his family.

Clyde passed away Tuesday morning, March 1, 2016 in the Scott & White

Hospital in Temple surrounded by his family. He was preceded in death by his parents; a brother, Louie Luetge, Jr. and a sister-in-law, Charlene Luetge.

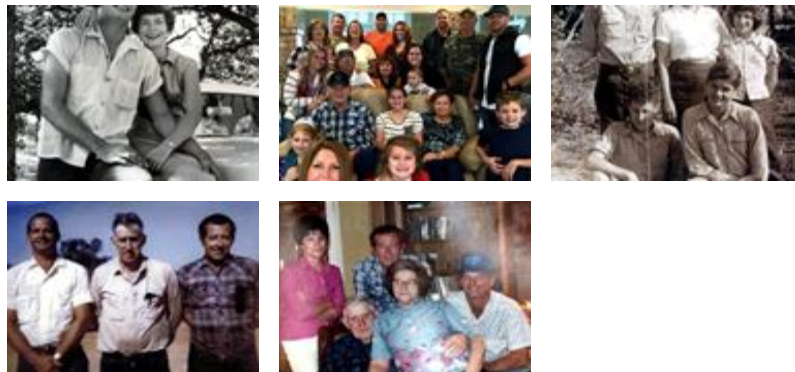

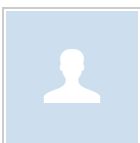
