



Colene Dunn Gaeke

October 4, 1932 - January 14, 2021

Colene Dunn Gaeke was born on October 4, 1932 in Blue Ridge, Texas, the daughter of Glenn & Tennie Dunn. She grew up and was baptized in the Baptist church and graduated from Giddings High School in 1950. Colene was united in marriage to Louis Gaeke Jr. on December 30, 1950. They were blessed with two sons, Robert and Douglas. Colene was an excellent seamstress, doing sewing work for many years and also worked with Louis in building their family business, Gaeke Construction Company, from the ground up. Colene was always the definition of a supportive wife, mother and grandmother to her family. She was active in the Boy Scouts and Little League while her sons were growing up and rarely missed any activities that involved her grandchildren. A faithful member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings, Colene had also been a member of the Giddings Study Club. The Brookwood Community in Brookshire held a special place in the hearts of both her and Louis. A huge supporter of the facility, she volunteered countless hours where she enjoyed teaching ceramics to the citizens. An avid gardener, she took great pride in the landscaping of her yard. The Gaeke home and yard were decorated for every holiday. The corner of Monroe Street and Knox Avenue would be turned into the spookiest of haunted houses, with Colene as the home's witch, for Halloween and into one of the brightest corners of Giddings when it was lit up with tens of thousands of Christmas lights complete with a larger-than-life Santa Claus. She was an amazing cook, enjoyed spending time at the family farm, loved going to the beach, especially

Galveston, and was a huge Texas A&M fan, rarely missing a home football game. Colene was known for many things including her sense of style, graciousness, warm hospitality and heartfelt compassion for others. Most importantly, she will be remembered as a supportive wife, loving mother and a doting grandmother.

Colene passed away the morning of Thursday, January 14, 2021 at Bec's Blessing in Giddings.

She is preceded in death by her father and stepmother, Glenn & Cora Mae Dunn and her mother, Tennie B. Foster.

Colene is survived by her loving husband of 70 years, Louis Gaeke Jr. of Giddings; her two sons, Robert "Bob" & Debbie Gaeke of San Antonio and Doug & Lisa Gaeke of Giddings; her four grandchildren, Brandon & Misty Gaeke of San Antonio, Brent Gaeke of Boerne, Audra Mayberry of Frisco, and Drew & Emily Gaeke of Giddings; her two great grandchildren, Anna Gaeke of San Antonio and Wyatt Mayberry of Frisco; one step brother, Alvin Dunn of Dallas; two brothers-in-law, Ed Gaeke of Chicago and William & Mary Lou Gaeke of Giddings; two sisters-in-law, Lucille Brannon of Brenham and Virginia & Charles Vavrecka of Pearland, as well as many other family members and friends.

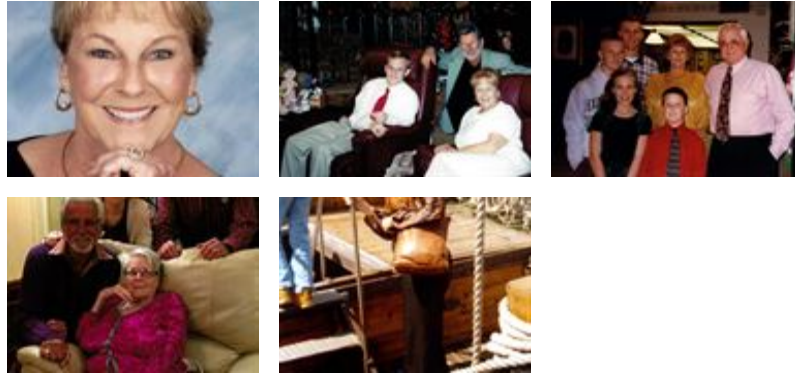
