Cruz Garza, Jr., age 64 of Rockdale passed away on Monday, September 30, 2024 in Schertz Texas.

A funeral Mass will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, October 5, 2024 at the St. Joseph's Catholic Church, burial will follow in the Garza Cemetery in Rockdale, Visitation will be held on Friday October 4, 2024 from 5:00 PM until 6:30 PM at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale. Cruz was born in Bryan, Texas on November 5, 1959 to Cruz Garza Sr. and Refugia Martinez. Cruz spent nearly all of his life in Rockdale, Texas. He graduated Rockdale High School in 1978 and was a lifelong member of St. Joseph Catholic Church.

Cruz married the love of his life, Teresa Ann Jezisek, on June 13, 1981 and remained married for 38 years. Cruz and Teresa had two sons, Jason and Steven. They lived and raised their children in Rockdale. Despite all of the challenges a 20+ year battle with cancer brings, Cruz never missed a family event and was involved in his children and grandchildren's life daily.
