



Curtis Leon Davis Jr.

Funeral services for Curtis Davis Jr., 58, of Giddings, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 7, 2020 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda, Texas with Rev. Curtis Leon Davis Jr. was born on January 10, 1962 in Livingston, Texas, the son of Curtis Leon Davis Sr. & Estelle Louise (Knox) Davis. He was united in marriage to Glenda Walther on July 11, 1981 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Houston by Rev. Laurence White. Curtis retired as a criminal investigator with the Bastrop County Sheriff's Department on July 31, 2018 after 24 years. He was a member of Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda. 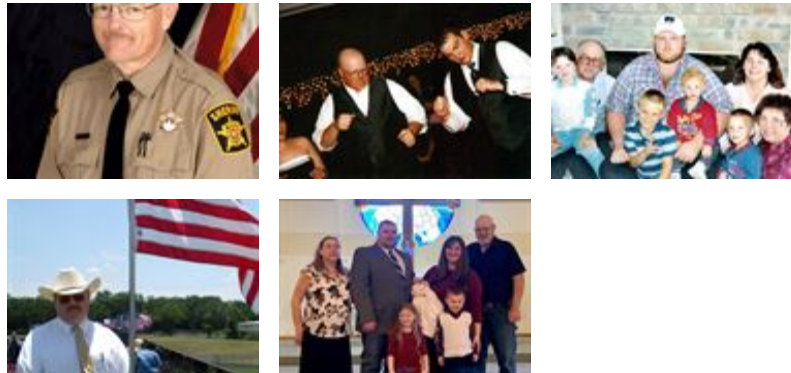

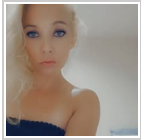
