



Daniel Basquez

July 22, 1933 - January 1, 2021

Funeral services for Daniel Basquez, 87 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 7, 2021 at St. Margaret Catholic Church in Giddings with Father Miguel Duarte officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, January 6, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, January 7, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. A Rosary will be recited Wednesday evening at 6:00 p.m. at the funeral home. Daniel Basquez was born on July 22, 1933 in Giddings, Texas, the son of Benito and Crespina (Castro) Basquez. He was united in marriage to Josephine Garcia on January 22, 1961 at St. Paul Catholic Church in Smithville, Texas. Daniel had worked at Invader Boats, Santa Fe Minerals and retired from LF Manufacturing. He was a lifelong and active member of St. Margaret Catholic Church in Giddings where he was president of the Sacred Heart Society, served as an usher and volunteered with the church's annual Fall Festival fundraiser. Daniel enjoyed being outside and was always working on something. He spent many hours watching Western movies. He loved being around his grandchildren and was always willing to do whatever they wanted. His family enjoyed listening to his stories from the past that he would tell and were always amazed at how he could remember names and dates

from things that happened so long ago. He was a devout Catholic, he always prayed the rosary daily in the morning, in the evening and in the vehicle when he traveled or when someone asked for prayers. He always gave his children and grandchildren a blessing, especially when traveling.

Daniel passed away the evening of Friday, January 1, 2021 at St. David's South Austin Medical Center.

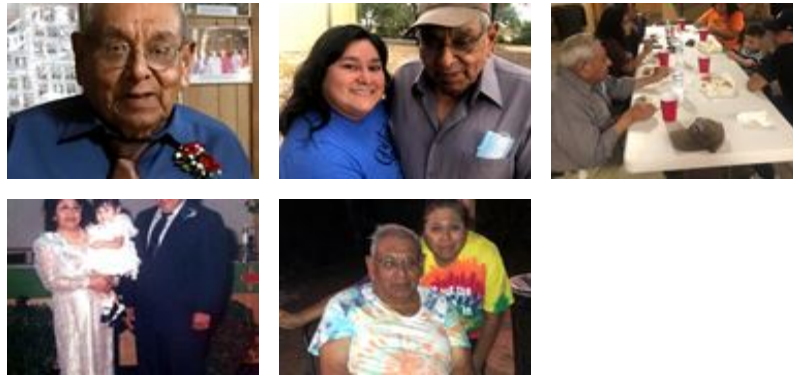

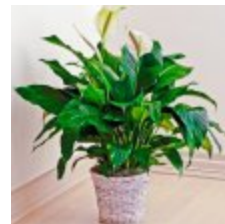
