



## Danny Robertson

October 31, 1946 - February 27, 2015

Memorial services for Danny Robertson, 68 of Rockdale and Midland are scheduled for 1:00 p.m. Saturday, March 7, 2015 in the Milam County Cowboy Church, 2100 North Highway 77, Rockdale, Texas with Pastor Greg Spears officiating. There will be a memorial service in Midland on Friday, March 20, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. in the Crestview Baptist Church, 301 North Loop 250 West.

Danny Robertson was born on October 31, 1946 in Midland, Texas. He was one of two sons born to the union of Leo and Marie Jo (Mann) Robertson. Danny was raised in Midland and attended school there. After high school he went to work for the City of Midland and retired in 2012 as the Assistant Superintendent of water/wastewater. While working for the City, he took college courses in connection with his position there. He also farmed part time while working for the City. Once he retired, he was a full time farmer and rodeo competitor in the calf roping. He met his wife Becky Youngblood, while competing in the Senior Rodeo Circuit and they were married in August at the rodeo in Hamilton.

Danny passed away Friday afternoon, February 28, 2015 in the Seton Hospital in Austin after a sudden illness. He was preceded in death by his parents, his brother James Robertson, and son-in-law Kerry Bragg.

Danny is survived by his wife, Becky Youngblood Robertson of Rockdale; son, Curtis Robertson and wife Chastity of Fairplay, Colorado; daughters, Danna Edwards and husband Michael of Midland and Karrie Bragg of Alpine; Step-son, Clint Deason and wife Holly of Jarrell; and 8 grandchildren, Stetson Edwards, Daniel Bragg, Makayla Robertson, Jager Robertson, Max Robertson, Ellie Mae Robertson, Kylee Deason, and Landon Deason.
