Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will immediately follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. The family will be present for visitation Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. with a prayer service being held at 7:00 p.m. Delbert Ben Geisler was born on December 13, 1932 in Burton, Texas to Benhard & Alvina (Treude) Geisler. He was baptized at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Greenvine and confirmed at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings. Delbert was a veteran of the U.S. Army and served during the Korean Conflict. He received his Honorable Discharge on December 3, 1953 having obtained the rank of Sergeant. He worked for the City of Houston Water Department for nearly 30 years. Delbert was united in marriage to Lillian Bargar on November 6, 1977 in Houston, Texas. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings where he had served as a elder. He was also a member of the Giddings American Legion York Post 276 and the Giddings VFW Post 4475 where he had served as Post Commander. Delbert enjoyed listening to Polka music, dancing, watching wrestling and barbequing. He passed away on Monday, March 3, 2014 at his home in Giddings. Delbert was preceded in

death by his parents; his wife, Lillian; his son, Clifford Geisler and two sisters, Doris Cervenka and Corine Alexander. He is survived by three sons and their families, Jerrell & Debbie Geisler of Houston and their son, Edward, Norman & Annalisa Geisler of Leander and their children, Allison & Wesley and Greg Geisler of Providence, Rhode Island and his children, Ryan, Lindsay and Evan; his brother and sister-in-law, Elroy & Jane Geisler of Giddings; his nephew who he considered a grandson, Mason Blasig of Giddings as well as numerous other nieces and nephews.
