Delward William Schautschick was born on August 30, 1939 in Giddings, Texas to Martin & Amanda (Berger) Schautschick. He was baptized on October 10, 1939 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. G.W. Fischer and confirmed on April 11, 1954 also at Immanuel Lutheran Church by Rev. Max Studtmann. His confirmation verse was John 8:31-32, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." Del was united in marriage to Betty Nora Pietsch on June 29, 1958 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas by Rev. Arthur Arndt. He started out farming while working at D & D Milling. He eventually joined Humble Exploration where he retired as yard manager. After Betty's death on November 10, 2006, Del married Bettie Lou Morris on January 29, 2011 in Giddings. He spent many years playing baseball and pitching in the local community baseball league. He enjoyed fishing, working in his yard, hog farming, barbecuing and watching sports. He was happiest when he was spending time with his family and friends.

Del passed away on Monday, October 15, 2018 at the College Station Medical Center.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Martin & Amanda Schautschick; his first wife, Betty Schautschick, and his brother, Walter Schautschick.

Del is survived by his wife, Bettie Schautschick of Giddings; his four children, Becky Proske & her husband, Gilbert of Giddings, Sandra Tomanetz & her husband, Dale of Giddings, Randy Schautschick of Giddings, and Rocky Schautschick of Giddings; three step children; one granddaughter, Ashley Atondo & her husband, Sergio of Dallas; nine step grandchildren and three step great grandchildren; one sister, Edna Houston & her husband, Melvin of Giddings; two brothers, Alvin Schautschick & his wife, Marilyn of Giddings, and Martin Schautschick Jr. & his wife, Ginny of Tanglewood; two sisters-in-law, Rose Shook & her husband, David of Waco, and Alice Williams & her husband, Bill of Waco as well as several nieces and nephews.
