June 12, 1955 - April 26, 2014

Dennis Wayne Dube, 58, of Giddings passed away unexpectedly at his home in Giddings on Saturday morning, April 26, 2014. Born on June 12, 1955 in Giddings, Dennis was the third child of Werner and Lydia (Richter) Dube. He was baptized into the Christian faith on June 26, 1955 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Reverend Max Studtmann. He publicly professed his faith through Confirmation on March 22, 1970 with Reverend Emil Krugler at Immanuel Lutheran Church. His Confirmation verse was Ephesians 2: 8-9 "For by grace are ye saved through faith and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast." He attended Immanuel Lutheran School and graduated from Giddings High School. For many years, he worked at the Exxon Bulk Plant in Giddings. At the time of his passing, he was employed as a dispatcher with the Lee County Sheriff's Office. Dennis enjoyed spending time with his family, fishing, mowing his yard, playing dominoes, watching football games and old western movies and listening to classic country and western music. He was preceded in death by his parents, Werner and Lydia Dube; his parents-in-law, Marvin and Mildred Kaechele and his brother-in-law, Douglas Moses. Dennis is survived by his sons, Christopher Dube of Giddings and Jason Dube, Sr. and wife Crystal of Lexington; his daughter, Teasha Sowders of Giddings; his grandchildren, Jason, Jr. and William Dube of Lexington and Emily Sowders of Giddings; his former wife and the mother of his children, Sue Kaechele Dube of Deanville. Joyce Urban and her husband, Henry of Paige and sisters-in-law, Dorothy Kaechele Moses of Somerville, Dee Plagens and her husband, Dick of Minnesota and Betty Tedford and her husband, Ronnie of Giddings. He is also survived by numerous nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, cousins, extended family and friends.
