



Dennis Louis Foerster

February 4, 1943 - February 9, 2020

Funeral services for Dennis Foerster, 77, of Manheim, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 13, 2020 at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim with Rev. Thomas Obersat Sr. officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, February 12, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, February 13, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Wednesday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Dennis Louis Foerster was called to his heavenly home during the early morning hours of Sunday, February 9, 2020 in Temple, Texas following a courageous fight with cancer.

Dennis was born on February 4, 1943 in Manheim, Texas to Alvin Fred Foerster and Bertha Magdalena Lucy (Umlang) Foerster. He was baptized into the Christian faith on February 21, 1943 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas by Rev. Reinhard Osthoff and confirmed on April 14, 1957 at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim by Rev. G. Naumann. His confirmation verse was John 10: 27-28, "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand." Dennis was united in marriage to Joyce Ann (Lehmann) Kieschnick on November 5, 1966 at Holy

Cross Lutheran Church in Warda, Texas.

After graduating from Giddings High School in 1961, Dennis attended Blinn College in Brenham. He then began operating heavy equipment until 1964 when he began working for Southern Pacific Railroad. In 1967, he began a 28-year career with Alcoa in Rockdale where he retired as a maintenance supervisor in 1995. After "retirement", Dennis began his own dozing business where he worked half days (12 hours). He always took an active role in his community. He served as treasurer of Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim, served on the Lee County Water Board, was an advisor at TSTC in Waco, a member of the Giddings Breakfast Lions Club, was a past director of ECAT and served as a director with API. His loves were doing custom dozing work, hunting, and spending quality time with family and friends.

Dennis is survived by his wife, Joyce Foerster of Manheim; his two daughters, Melissa (Kieschnick) Galipp & her husband, Wayne of Giddings, and Karen Hester of Giddings; two granddaughters, Dr. Kari Galipp & her husband, Dr. Eric Friedrich of Oklahoma and Katelyn Hester of San Antonio; three sisters-in-law, Eunice Foerster of Manheim, Brenda Woelfel & her husband, Larry of Warda, and Carolyn Lehmann of Warda; two nieces, Rhonda Lehmann & her husband, Darvin of Manheim and Renee Williams & her husband, Kyle of Waco; two nephews, Kevin Foerster & his wife, Krista of Manheim and Mark Woelfel & his wife, Sunny of Warda and other extended family members and friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Alvin & Lucy Foerster; two brothers, James Foerster and an infant brother, Ronnie Foerster, and his parents-in-law, Louis P. & Amanda Lehmann and Edward & Hattie Kieschnick.

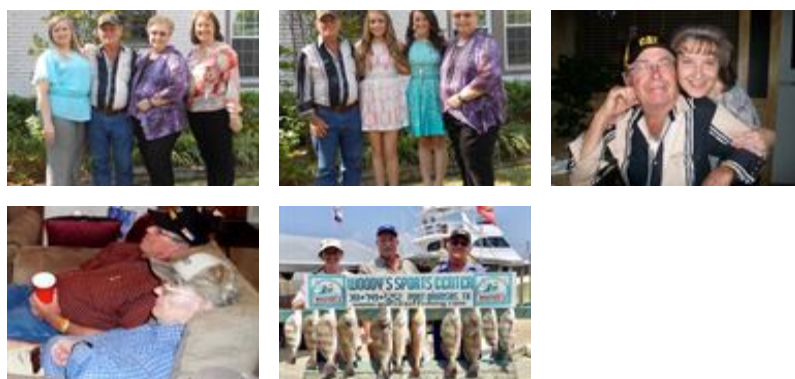

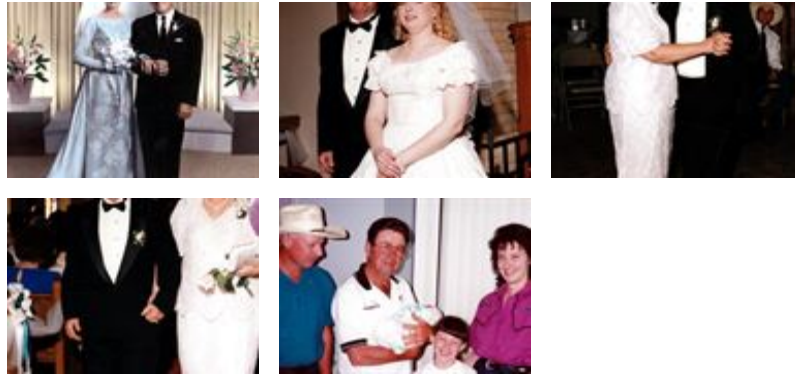
