



## Dennis Lee Zwernemann

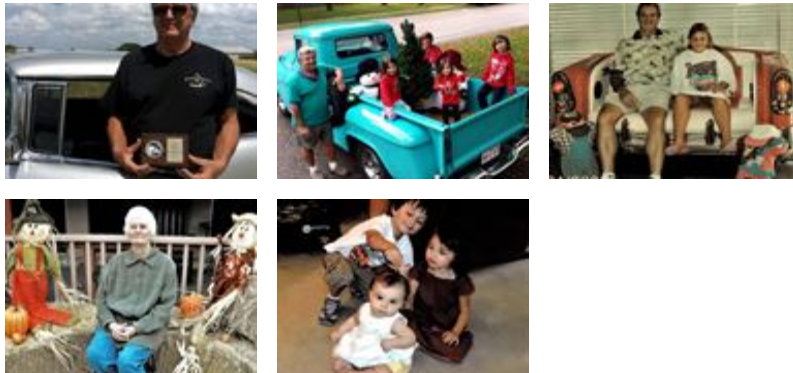
