Funeral services for Dolores Tonn, 87, of Giddings will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 3, 2024 at St. Margaret Catholic Church in Giddings with Father Javier Toscano officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. 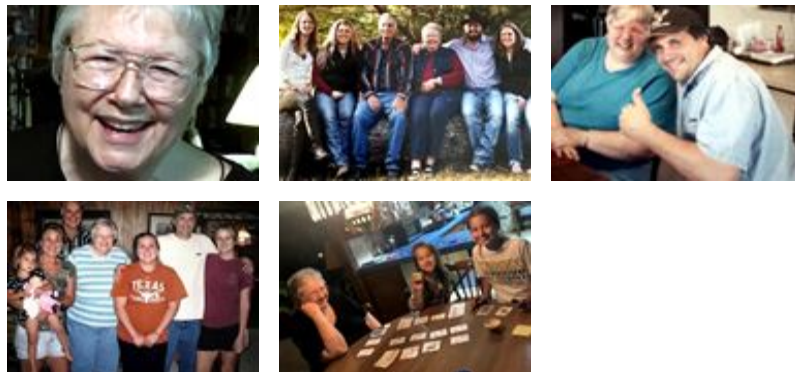
