



Donald "Donnie" Keith Blasig

January 14, 1959 - December 30, 2020

Funeral services for Donald "Donnie" Blasig, 61 of Giddings, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 3, 2021 at First Baptist Church in Giddings with Tim Pitts and Shannon Namken officiating. Burial will follow in St. John Lutheran Cemetery in Dime Box, Texas. Visitation will be held on Saturday, January 2, 2021 from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Sunday, January 3, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. Donald Keith Blasig was born on January 14, 1959 in Giddings, Texas, the son of Milton Lee Blasig and Allyne Emma (Bage) Blasig. He was baptized and confirmed at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim, Texas. He graduated from Giddings High School in 1977 and attended Concordia University in Austin. Donnie married Valla Michalk on September 29, 1979 at the First Baptist Church in Giddings. He worked at Sports n Stuff in Giddings for several years before going to work at the Giddings State School in 1987 as a Juvenile Correction Officer. He worked there for 25 years, retiring in 2012. Donnie was a local home builder having owned and operated Blasig Construction for the past 15 years. He always had an ongoing project and loved designing homes. He was a member of the First Baptist Church in

Giddings and served as a coach for the Lee County Little League, and Giddings Optimist soccer, flag football, and basketball programs for 26 years. Donnie loved vacationing, traveling, and doing anything with his family, especially spending time with and spoiling his grandchildren. He enjoyed fishing and was a huge fan of the Texans, Astros, Rockets, and Longhorns.

Donnie passed away on Wednesday, December 30, 2020 at Baylor Scott and White Medical Center in College Station, Texas.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Milton & Allyne Blasig; his step-mother, Dorothy Moerbe Blasig; his parents-in-law, Herbert & Ima Jo Michalk, and two brothers-in-law, Curtis Namken and Bill Hilton.
