



## Dora Irene Durrenberger

July 26, 1934 - December 4, 2024

Funeral services for Dora Durrenberger, 90 of Giddings, Texas, are scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, December 7, 2024 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Friday, December 6, 2024 from 11:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday, December 7, 2024 from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Friday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Dora Irene (Albrecht) Durrenberger was born on July 26, 1934 in Paige, Texas to Otto and Louise (Marburger) Albrecht. She was baptized on September 9, 1934 at St. John Lutheran Church in Paige by Rev. G.A. Poehlmann and confirmed on March 28, 1948 also at St. John Lutheran Church in Paige by Rev. Walter K. Doege. Her confirmation verse was Hebrews 11:1. "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." She graduated from Giddings High School and attended Blinn College in Brenham. On October 25, 1953, Dora was united in marriage to Van Autry G. Durrenberger at St. John Lutheran Church in Paige by Rev. B. Recks. She worked at the Chevrolet Dealership in Giddings before she and Van opened Durrenberger Flowers in Giddings. They owned and operated the nursery business and flower shop until retiring in 1995. Throughout her life, she was a member of St. John Lutheran Church in Paige, Martin Luther Lutheran Church

in Giddings, where she was a member of the Ladies Aid, Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings and finally at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin. Dora enjoyed gardening and coin collection, of which she gave many to her grandchildren. In addition, she also had an extensive collection of Fenton Glass of which she traveled to several states to acquire certain pieces of her collection. She and Van also traveled several times to Branson, Missouri where they enjoyed listening to the musical performances.

Dora passed away the morning of Wednesday, December 4, 2024 at her home in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Otto and Louise Albrecht; her husband, Van Durrenberger; her son, Marcus Durrenberger; her sister and brother-in-law, Evelyn & Bill Miertschin, and her brother, Leon Albrecht.

Dora is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, Jeffery & Lisa Durrenberger of Giddings; two grandchildren, Brittney & Justin Weyand of Brenham and Logan Durrenberger of Giddings; two great grandchildren, Iris & Bud Weyand of Brenham; sister-in-law, Marie Albrecht of Paige as well as several nieces and nephews.

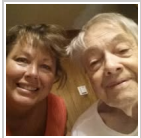
