



Dorathy "Dot" Kathleen Westfall

July 1, 1937 - October 24, 2022

Funeral services for Dorathy "Dot" Westfall, 85 of Giddings, are scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on Friday, October 28, 2022 at the First Baptist Church in Giddings with Tim Pitts officiating. Burial will follow in Giddings Memorial Park. Visitation will be held on Thursday, October 27, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Friday, October 28, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Dorathy Kathleen (Leinweber) Westfall was born on July 1, 1937 in Hondo, Texas, the only child born to Fritz and Naomi (Shoor) Leinweber. She graduated from Hondo High School in 1955. She attended Southwest Texas State in San Marcos and received her degree in 1959. On June 27, 1959, Dot was united in marriage to Leon Westfall at the United Methodist Church in Hondo. She began her teaching career in Hondo and D'Hanis as a home economics teacher before moving to Giddings in 1961. She next taught at Giddings Elementary School and later retired after 31 years in education. She was active in the Giddings Study Club, the Seton Development Board, and at First Baptist Church in Giddings where she was a member of the LTN Class and served on numerous committees. Dot was a cancer survivor for the past forty-three years having beaten cancer in 1979. She could often be found cooking, sewing, quilting, and watching grandchildren play sports. She enjoyed walking along the beach, collecting seashells, shopping with friends,

traveling, was a huge baseball fan, and loved Christmas. Her greatest joy was sharing time with her family and watching her grandchildren and great grandchildren participate in their favorite activities.

Dot passed away the morning of Monday, October 24, 2022 at her home in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents.

Dot is survived by her husband, Leon Westfall of Giddings; her daughter and son-in-law, Sharon & Steve Buck of Giddings; her son and daughter-in-law, Doug & Robin Westfall of Giddings; four grandsons, Cody Buck & his wife, Melissa of Victoria, Trent Buck & his wife, Andrea of College Station, Ethan Westfall & his wife, Laura of Hubbard, and Elliott Westfall of Giddings; great grandchildren, Emerson and Garrett Buck of Victoria, Paige, Kate, and Travis Buck of College Station, and Wyatt and “soon to arrive” Laurel Westfall of Hubbard, and many dear extended family members and special friends.

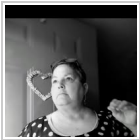

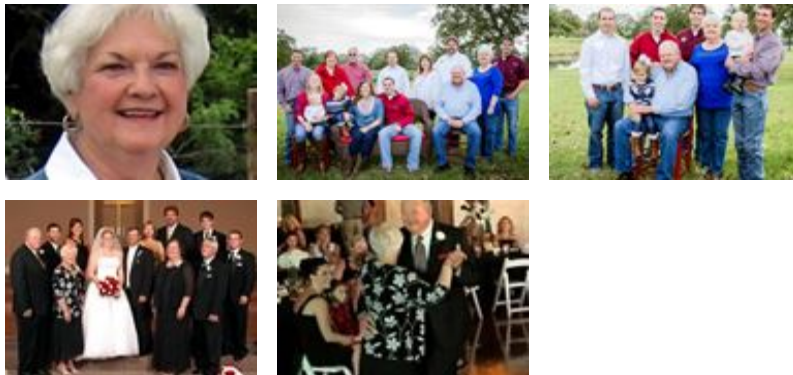
