



## Doris Elenora (Hitchcock) Brewer

July 17, 1933 - June 21, 2015

Doris (Hitchcock) Brewer, 81, of Caldwell passed away on Sunday, June 21, 2015 at St. Joseph Regional Health Center in Bryan, TX. A Memorial Service commemorating her life will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 27, 2015 at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Caldwell with Rev. Geary O. McManus officiating. The family will greet and receive guests from 1:00-2:00 p.m., prior to the Memorial Service.

Doris was born July 17, 1933 to Jessie A. Hitchcock and Elenora Phillips Hitchcock in the Providence Community of Burleson County, TX. She was the youngest of seven children. On November 24, 1967, she married A.W. Brewer.

After graduating from Caldwell High School in 1950, she moved to Dallas, TX to attend business school. Shortly thereafter, Doris began her 55 years of employment at the Burleson County Courthouse. During this time, Doris held several positions including court reporter, secretary to the county judge, secretary to the county attorney, Deputy District Clerk, and as temporary Justice of The Peace. In 1981, she was appointed District Clerk where she served in that capacity until her retirement on December 31, 2006.

Doris also served her community spending many years working with the Burleson County Fair Association, the American Cancer Society, and various other organizations. She was an excellent cook and enjoyed providing food for family and church gatherings.

Doris was preceded in death by her parents; two brothers, Howard G. and

Philip (Bobby) Hitchcock; one sister, Inez Emerson; brother-in-laws, Ernest Emerson and C.A. Grimsley, and sister-in-law, Ann Hitchcock. Survivors include two brothers, Grabow and Andrew Hitchcock, both of Caldwell; one sister, Bettye Grimsley of Center, TX; one sister-in-law, Joyce Hitchcock; three nephews, Gerald Grimsley and wife Janet, Phil Hitchcock and wife Donna, and De Hitchcock and wife Shelly; two nieces, Sarah Hitchcock Robertson and Karlis Hitchcock; great-nephew, Joshua Hitchcock, and great-nieces, Kodi Lynn and Andi Leigh Hitchcock.
