



Doris Hattie Mitschke

August 31, 1941 - March 1, 2016

Funeral services for Doris Mitschke, 74, of Serbin, Texas, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 6, 2016 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday, March 5, 2016 from 10:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and on Sunday, March 6, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Saturday evening from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Doris Hattie Mitschke was born on August 31, 1941, the daughter of Albert Edwin Mitschke and Hattie Anna Ernestine (Medack) Mitschke, in Serbin, Texas. She was baptized on September 7, 1941 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Herman Schmidt and was confirmed on April 3, 1955 at Christ Lutheran Church in Houston by Rev. Gerhardt Obenhaus. Doris was raised in Houston, Texas and she worked at Prudential Insurance Company in Houston and Jacksonville, Florida before retiring in 1994. After retirement, she moved to the family farm in Serbin. She enjoyed sewing and crafts, especially making quilts for Lutheran World Relief.

Doris went to be with her Lord the evening of Tuesday, March 1, 2016 at St. David's Medical Center in Austin following a brief but hard fought battle against cancer.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Albert & Hattie Mitschke.

Doris is survived by her two sisters, Jarrene Mitschke of Serbin and Gloria Hoppens and her husband, Randal of Brenham; one nephew, Nathan Hoppens of Austin; one niece, Sarah Engman & her husband, Nathan of Katy; two great nephews, Samuel and Luke Engman of Katy as well as various aunts, uncles and cousins.

“Doris and I met 54 yrs ago at Prudential. We were friends at work and outside of work. She went to Fla. with Prudential and I stayed in Houston. I told him it was Doris who made the quilt. He said "O no that lady who made that great green quilt can't be dead". She will be missed sorely for her love and kindness as well as for her quilts. Hopefully we will meet again.

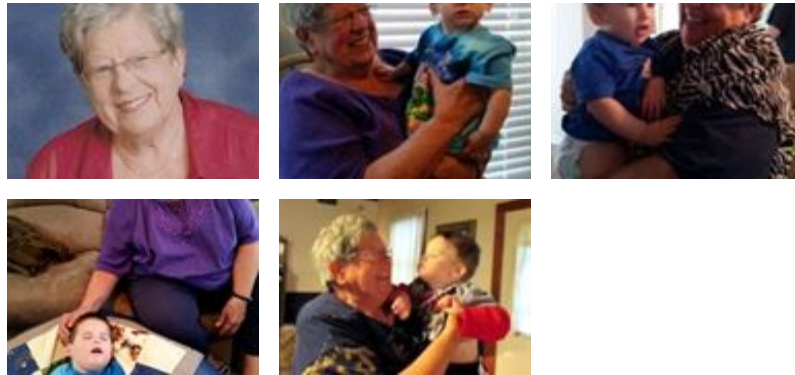
