She graduated as salutatorian and yearbook editor at Giddings High School in 1937 and later embarked on a 38 year teaching career that included the Giddings area, Port Bolivar, Galveston and San Antonio where she retired in 1983. In 1992 she moved to Austin to be closer to her sons and in 2002 she returned to the Giddings area to live out the remainder of her days.

Throughout her life she always had a love of gardening, art, writing, and playing the piano and accordion.

She was preceded in death by her parents Emil and Matilda Simmang; siblings Ted Simmang, John Simmang, Aileen McClellan, Q.W. Simmang, Gertrude York; and her son Glen Simmang Ivey. She is survived by her children Karl Ivey and wife Sally of Fulton, Kentucky; Alan Allert and wife Rebecca of Giddings; Arthur Allert of Austin; grandchildren Anna Keel and husband Scott of Apalachicola, Florida; Glen Ivey and wife Renae of Memphis, Tennessee; and Will Ivey and wife Maria of Madrid, Spain.
