Dorothy graduated from Giddings High School in 1939 and worked at various jobs before and during World War II. Dorothy was an active member of Martin Luther Lutheran Church where she had served as a Sunday school and vacation bible school teacher for over 15 years. She also was a member of the Martin Luther Lutheran Church Women of the Word and had served as the president of the organization. She was a member of the Ledbetter Volunteer Fire Department Auxiliary and the Giddings Sons of Hermann Lodge #54. Dorothy was heavily involved in the Stalag 17B Former POW's organization and faithfully attended their annual

conventions and had served as the facilitator for their fundraising. She enjoyed dancing and dominoes as well as traveling. Dorothy passed away at her home in Ledbetter during the early morning hours of Tuesday, October 30, 2012. She was preceded in death by her parents, A.T. & Meta Alexander; her husband, Clarence R.
