Douglas Albert Robbins was born on April 20, 1925 in Waco, Texas to William Gentry Robbins Sr. and Thelma (Stigall) Robbins. He was united in marriage to Nann Mary Camp Reid on August 23, 1971 in Lincoln, Nebraska.

Pastor Robbins was ordained in Thawville, Illinois in 1960 and became a beloved, longtime minister in the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod, faithfully serving congregations in Illinois, Iowa, Missouri and Texas. He retired as the pastor of Trinity Lutheran Church in Old Dime Box, Texas on November 26, 2006.
