

Dovie Corena Hill

April 20, 1943 - October 18, 2021

A memorial service for Dovie Hill, 78 of Giddings, is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 28, 2021 at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Regan Hill and Kenny Smith officiating.

Dovie Corena (Hammock) Hill was born on April 20, 1943 in Lepanto, Arkansas to Virgle Othy Hammock and Nellie Corena (Morgan) Hammock. She was married to James Franklin Hill on January 27, 1962. On August 12, 1967, she was baptized at Shannon Baptist Church in Pocahontas, Arkansas. Dovie and James lived back and forth between Texas and Arkansas during the 1980's while James worked in the oil field. They finally settled in Giddings. She was a teacher who taught in school in Texas and Arkansas. She also operated her own school, the Maynard Christian Academy in Arkansas, at one time. Dovie was a talented artist who used her talent to create artwork, murals, and signage for cities and created the eagle in flight that is used by Lexington I.S.D. She was a very self-sufficient individual. She was an excellent seamstress who could make clothing without a pattern which led her to open her own seamstress shop. She had a garden that spanned over two acres and canned the produce she grew. She and James also raised cattle, hogs, chickens, and had 85 hives of bees. She will be remembered as a patient person who was a great listener and had a calming presence.

Dovie passed away the morning of Monday, October 18, 2021 at St. David's

Medical Center in Austin.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her brother, Roy & Jewel Hammock, and her brother-in-law, Clifford Britt.

Dovie is survived by her husband, James Hill of Giddings; seven children, Jimmy D. Hill of Maybank, Toni Nance of Yellville, AR, Barclay & Pam Hill of Victoria, Andrew & Linda Hill of Jonesboro, AR, Corbitt & Amber Hill of Giddings, Regan & Kimberly Hill of Giddings, and Kerry & David Devenport of Giddings; twelve grandchildren, Nichole, Caleb, Ladonna, and Gloria Nance of Arkansas, Elizabeth Hill of Victoria, Courtney Hill and Crystal Hill of Arkansas, Joshua Hill and Paul Hill of Giddings, Meri Hill and Renae Thac of Houston, and Mary Devenport of Giddings; ten great grandchildren; one sister, Betty Britt of Mississippi; one brother, J.C. & Josie Hammock of Somerville; her best friend, Joanna Ohnanik of Missouri, as well as several nieces and nephews.

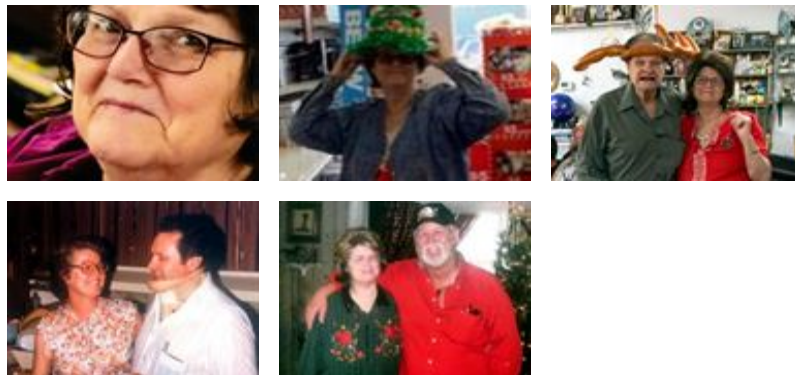
