



Edgar Overman

September 27, 1928 - July 21, 2018

Edgar Overman, 89, of Marble Falls, Texas, passed away Saturday, July 21, 2018. Graveside services will be held on Edgar and Rosalie's 70th wedding anniversary, July 24, 2018 at 1:00 P.M. Tuesday at the Oak Lawn Cemetery in Rockdale. Visitation will be from 11:30 A.M. till 12:30 P.M. Tuesday July 24, 2018 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale.

Edgar was born, at home, in Oak Hill, a small farming community, not far from Rockdale, on September 27, 1928. He was one of ten children born to Noah Hilliard and Mary Josephine (Sides) Overman. Edgar spent his childhood and young adulthood farming in the communities of Pleasant Hill and Tracy where he attended High School. He and his twin brother Earl, moved to Houston in July of 1945, and lived in a garage apartment, with his eldest sister Ruby and her husband Albert Holliman and later the twin brothers moved into a duplex, that was owned by another older sister Evelyn Caffey and her husband James Alton Caffey.

In September of 1945, Edgar started working at Rainbow Baking Co. It was there, in 1947, he met his future wife Rosalie Brockman. Edgar and Rosalie were married on July 24, 1948. Edgar worked at Rainbow Baking Co. for twenty-three years, spending two years in the Army, from January of 1953 to February of 1955. Rosalie gave birth to their only child, Edgar Overman Jr., on August 12, 1954. Edgar left Rainbow Baking Co. in March of 1968. In 1972

Edgar started his final job at Van Leer Plastics, where he retired from in March of 1990. In April of 1994 Edgar and Rosalie left Houston and moved to Marble Falls TX. where they bought a house on Lake Travis near to the place where they spent many, (approximately 30) years having family reunions, camping, fishing, boating, and skiing. The yearly reunions at Lake Travis remain as the best of memories to all of the nieces and nephews from our whole family. Edgar and Rosalie also enjoyed a lasting relationship with all their family, camping and fishing at Toledo Bend Reservoir, spending quality time together.

Edgar was preceded in death by both parents; his five sisters, Ruby Holliman, Ruth Lewis, Evelyn Caffey, Ora Moseley, Nora Morris; and four brothers, Frank, Robert, Billy, and Earl Overman.

Edgar is survived by his wife, Rosalie Brockman Overman; son, Edgar Overman Jr. & wife Paulyne; granddaughter, Sabrina Frederick; and great granddaughter, Hailey Frederick.
