



## Edmund Albert Iselt

September 1, 1935 - June 20, 2020

Funeral services for Edmund Iselt, 84 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 23, 2020 at the Christ Lutheran Church Pavilion in Loebau, Texas with Rev. Garrett Smith officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Edmund Albert Iselt was born on September 1, 1935 in Loebau, Texas to Louis Alfred Iselt and Freida Mathilda (Lehmann) Iselt. He was baptized on September 16, 1935 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau by Rev. William Remmert and confirmed on April 2, 1950 also at Christ Lutheran Church by Rev. Herbert Hartfield. His confirmation verse was John 10: 27-28, "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand." Edmund was united in marriage to Frances Bernice Schulze on November 29, 1953 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau by Rev. Herbert Hartfield. Edmund was the manager of the NAPA store in Giddings for over 20 years. He eventually retired as the maintenance supervisor at Bluebonnet Electric in Giddings. Edmund loved being outdoors and enjoyed vegetable and flower gardening, hunting and fishing, especially fishing trips to the coast. He spent many hours doing woodworking projects and building things. He was excellent at making

barbeque, especially ribs and loved spending time with his family.

Edmund passed away during the early morning hours of Saturday, June 20, 2020 at St. David's South Austin Medical Center.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother and sister-in-law, Willie George Iselt and Joyce Iselt, and a sister-in-law, Ellen Schulze.

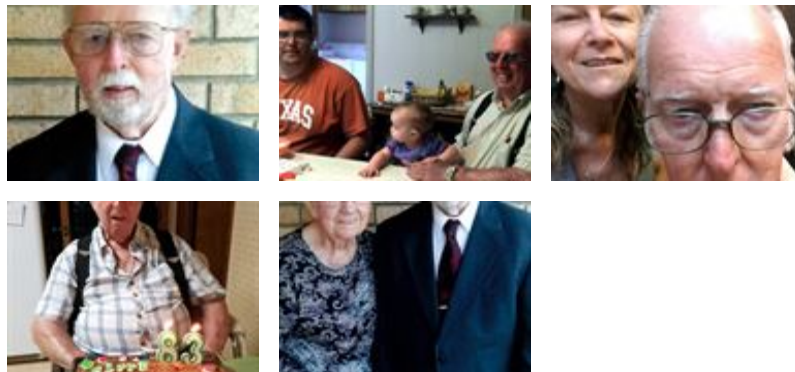
