Edna Leona Kasper Krause was born on October 14, 1937, in Winchester, Texas, to Rudolph H. Kasper and Hermine Reinhardt Kasper. Edna grew up in Winchester, where she helped her family with many chores, including driving a tractor and picking cotton. She attended La Grange High School in La Grange, Texas.

On September 21, 1958, Edna married the love of her life, Ludwig Carl Krause, in her home church, St. Michael's Lutheran Church, in Winchester, Texas.
