



## Edna Louise Richter

August 19, 1932 - August 9, 2021

Funeral services for Edna Richter, 88, of Fedor, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, August 13, 2021 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor with Rev. Jonathan Meyer officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Thursday, August 12, 2021 from 12:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Friday, August 13, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Edna Louise (Dube) Richter was born on August 19, 1932 in Fedor, Texas, the daughter of Albert Herman Dube and Otilie Selma (Urban) Dube. She was baptized on August 28, 1932 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor by Rev. Adolph Michalk and confirmed on April 14, 1946 also at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church by Rev. Paul Brust. Her confirmation verse was John 10:27-29, "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand". Edna was united in marriage to Henry August Richter on February 24, 1951. They had one son, Andrew. Edna and Henry lived in Houston for many years. After Henry's death in 2001, she moved back to Fedor. She was a longtime member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor. She enjoyed baking, playing dominoes and kept an immaculate home and yard. More than anything, Edna enjoyed getting

together and visiting with family and friends. She will be remembered as a giving person who would do anything for anyone and never thought of herself.

Edna passed away the evening of Monday, August 9, 2021 at Oakland Manor Nursing Center in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Albert & Otilie Dube; her husband of nearly 50 years, Henry Richter; three brothers, Carl Dube, Werner Dube, and Herman Dube, and three sisters, Ella Schroeder, Evelyn Schroeder, and Marie Schneider.

Edna is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, Andrew & Rebecca Richter of Temple; her sister, Margaret Richter of Fedor; two nieces to whom she was like a second mother, Sharon Schimank & her husband, Curtis of Lincoln and Karen Patschke & her husband, Kenneth of Lexington, as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

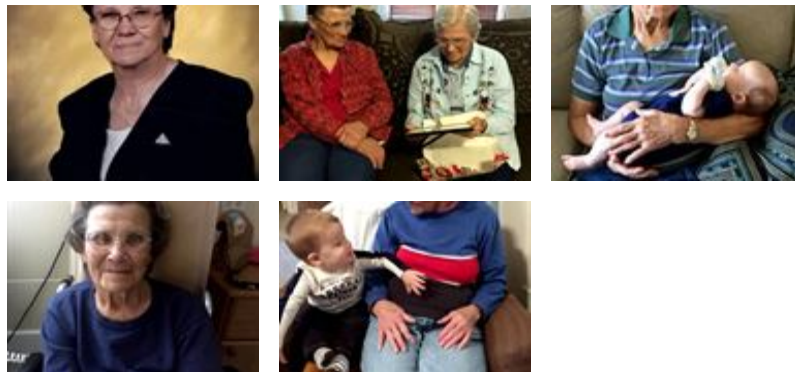
