



Edward "Bud" Carl Bohl

Funeral services for Edward "Bud" Bohl, 93 of Lexington, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 2, 2016 at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington with Rev. Edward Carl Bohl was born on October 3, 1922 in Caldwell, Texas to Frank & Martha (Ahrendt) Bohl. He was baptized on December 24, 1922 and confirmed on September 12, 1938 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lexington, Texas. He married Vila Joy McKee on September 13, 1947 in San Antonio, Texas. They were blessed with two daughters, Pamela and Sherry. Joy preceded him in death on November 14, 1994 after 47 years of marriage. Edward served in the U.S. Army from August 4, 1943 until receiving his Honorable Discharge on February 6, 1946 having obtained the rank of Technician Fourth Grade. While in the Army, he served in New Guinea, the Southern Philippines and Luzon. Edward retired after 30 years of service with the U.S. Air Force Civil Service at Kelly Air Force Base in San Antonio where he was the supervisor of paints, plastic and wood shop. He was a member of St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington and the Sons of Hermann Harmonia Lodge #1. Edward enjoyed fishing, carpentry work and taking care of and spending time with his great grandchildren. He passed away the afternoon of

Monday, December 28, 2015 at his home in Lexington.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Frank & Martha Bohl; his wife, Joy Bohl; two brothers, Fred Bohl and Frank Bohl Jr. and a sister, Bertha Powitsky.
