



Edwin "Ed" Lee Eargle Jr.

Funeral services for Edwin "Ed" Eargle Jr., 80 of La Grange, Texas, are scheduled for 10:30 a.m. on Monday, August 9, 2021 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Carmine, Texas with Rev. 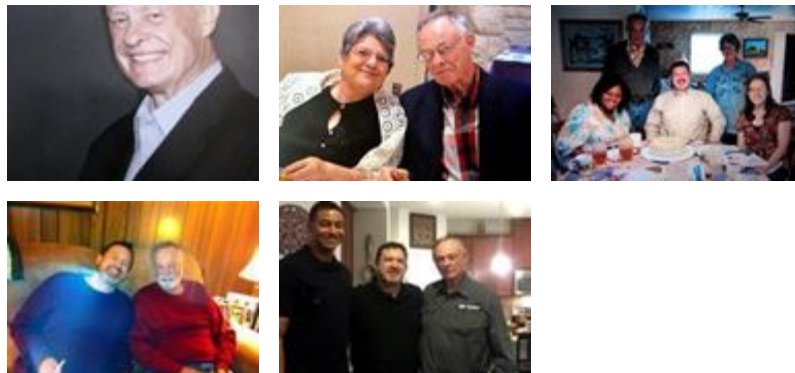
