As a Crowe and Edwin as my best friend I will tell you we don't get it just right. And Edwin could read music. He knew that but he still loved #990. He also loved hunting, fishing, fixing anything mechanical and taking his Grand daughter, Kalilou, for a ride on his motorcycle after work. Or, maybe she had him wrapped around her little finger? I really don't think he liked these things more than he liked going to church... he tried on different occasions to get myself and others to sneak him out of the hospital and take him to worship God.

Yes, November the eighth two thousand twenty five I Lost my all-time favorite running buddy. I have had a lot of friends over the years but never one I connected with like Edwin. We liked the same things from picking on our wives to XXXX HOT Cajun shrimp and craw fish.
