Edwin Schumacher, 85, of Caldwell, entered into rest on Sunday, February 26, 2017 surrounded by family. Graveside services will be held on Wednesday, March 1, at the Elizabeth Lutheran Cemetery at 11 am. Viewing will be held from 10 to 11 before the services in the cemetery. Pastor Richard E. Edwin Schumacher was born to his parents Gus and Sophia (Krueger) Schumacher on October 19, 1931 in the county of Burleson. He was raised around the Big Creek and Frenstat communities. He went to the Lyons and Big Creek schools in his youth. Edwin was baptized and confirmed in the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Lyons, TX. He changed his membership to Elizabeth Lutheran Church when he moved to Caldwell. When Edwin was in the sixth grade he left school to help his parents on the farm. In his early twenties, his parents retired from farming, so he went out into the working world. He became a carpenter and worked at Invader Boat in Deanville before it moved to Giddings. Edwin was very skilled carpenter and was self employed for many years. Edwin was a very helpful person always showing and teaching how to do projects for friends and neighbors. He was also an avid fisher and loved to take his wife Irene out dancing. Edwin also liked to do puzzles in his free time.

Edwin was preceded in death by his parents, Gus and Sophia Schumacher; three of his sisters, Velma Poehls, Lillian Neimann, Olga Schumacher; and a

brother, Henry Schumacher.

He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Irene (Prieve) Schumacher; a son, Dennis Schumacher; a daughter, Ann Amaya and husband Daniel; a brother, Walter Schumacher and wife Vivian; a sister, Laura Whited; a grandson, Mathew Amaya; and numerous nieces and nephews.
