Effie Ellen Gay Owens, a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, sister, and faithful servant of Jehovah, peacefully passed away on October 31, 2025, in Rockdale, Texas, at the age of 94.

Born in Lexington, Texas, in Lee County, Effie was the cherished daughter of Thadius “Dick” Gay and Martha Reynolds Gay. She received her early education in Lexington and later attended Durham Business College in Austin, Texas.
