



Elaine Lillian Crow

Funeral services for Elaine Crow, 75 of Ledbetter, Texas, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Friday, March 20, 2015 at St. John's United Church of Christ in Burton, Texas with Pastor Greg Felder officiating. Committal services will follow at 5:00 p.m. at the Giddings Memorial Park in Giddings, Texas.
