



Ellen Naomi Schneider

July 14, 1936 - December 5, 2021

Funeral services for Ellen Schneider, 85 of Giddings, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 9, 2021 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner and Vicar Josh Hahn officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, December 8, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, December 9, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. Ellen Naomi (Krause) Schneider was born on July 14, 1936 in Serbin, Texas, the youngest daughter of John Herman Krause and Alma Bertha (Hohle) Krause. Due to an illness, she was baptized on July 14, 1936 at home by Rev. Herman Schmidt. Ellen attended St. Paul Lutheran School in Serbin and was confirmed on March 18, 1951 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Arthur Arndt. Her confirmation verse was John 14:6, "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." On November 11, 1956, she was united in marriage to Gilbert Schneider at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Arthur Arndt. They made their home on the farm in Lincoln, Texas. On October 24, 1981, Gilbert passed away and Ellen then made her home in Giddings. She enjoyed working in her garden and tending to her flowers and taking care of her dogs and cats. Although Gilbert and Ellen never had any children of their own, the Lord blessed them with numerous

nieces and nephews that she was very fond of. She spent her last year at Oakland Manor Nursing Center where she had many friends and enjoyed games of dominoes and bingo. She also enjoyed the visits from Pastor Tiner and Vicar Hahn.

Ellen passed away the morning of Sunday, December 5, 2021 at Oakland Manor Nursing Center in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Gilbert Schneider; parents, John & Alma Krause; four sisters, Esther King & her husbands, Martin Prellop, Carl Mitschke, & Daniel King, Ruth Teinert & her husband, Herbert, Lorine Zoch & her husband, Herbert, Irene Kasper, & her husband, Harold; four brothers, Harold Krause, Arnold Krause, Paul Krause, and Elton Krause, and two brothers-in-law, Raymond Nietzsche and Delmus Franks.

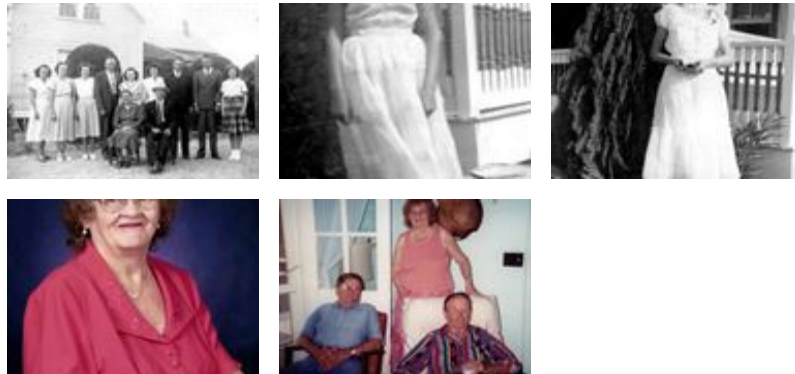
