



Elmer Louis "Lou" Weller

August 3, 1948 - January 27, 2017

A memorial service has been planned for Elmer Louis "Lou" Weller to be held 1:00 p.m. Saturday, February 4, 2017 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale. Burial of the ashes will follow in the Oak Lawn Cemetery in Rockdale.

Lou Weller was born August 3, 1948 in Springfield, Illinois to Elmer Lloyd and Delores Irene (Nolan) Weller. He graduated from High School and attended college and received his Bachelor's degree. On April 19, 1973 he and Mary Helen Collins were married in Pekin, Illinois. Lou was an Ironworker with Keystone Steel and Wire and a member of Iron and Steelworkers union. They came to Rockdale in 1989 from Troup, Texas. He worked for the City of Rockdale and then was a crew leader with the City of Round Rock until his retirement.

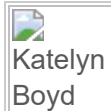

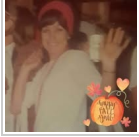
