August 4, 1939 - February 21, 2020

Elmore Lincoln, a lifelong resident of Thorndale, passed away Friday morning, February 21, 2020 in the Cedar Park Regional Medical Center in Cedar Park at the age of 80. He was born August 4, 1939 in the Salty Community to Hugh Anthony and Willie Ollie (Byrd) Lincoln. On September 4, 1964 he and Sarah Grace Gary were married in St. John's United Methodist Church in Rockdale. Elmore worked at Alcoa for 39 and a half years and retired in January 1, 2000 from the Environmental Control Department. He was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Thorndale. He supported and was involved in Thorndale as a former Thorndale City Councilman and served as Mayor Pro Tem and was an honorary member of Thorndale Volunteer Fire Department. Elmore was a daily member of the Thorndale Cefco Coffee Group. He loved to garden and enjoyed doing yard work and roller skating.

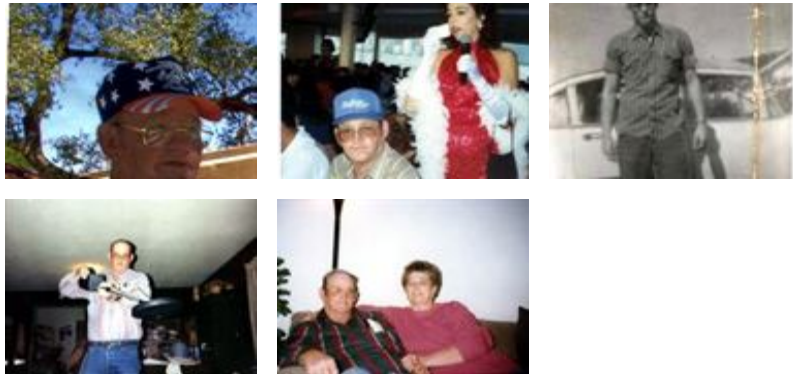
